The northern portion of 132nd Ave NE from NE 132nd street on is a walk route for schoolchildren from both Kamiakin Middle School and Jon Muir Elementary. Some of these children live at the Kamaikin Heights housing project and do not have parental trasportation to/from school therefore rely on unsupervised daily walks along 132nd. As traffic speeds have increased along this roadway this puts all individuals either walking along or attempting to cross 132nd Ave at risk.
