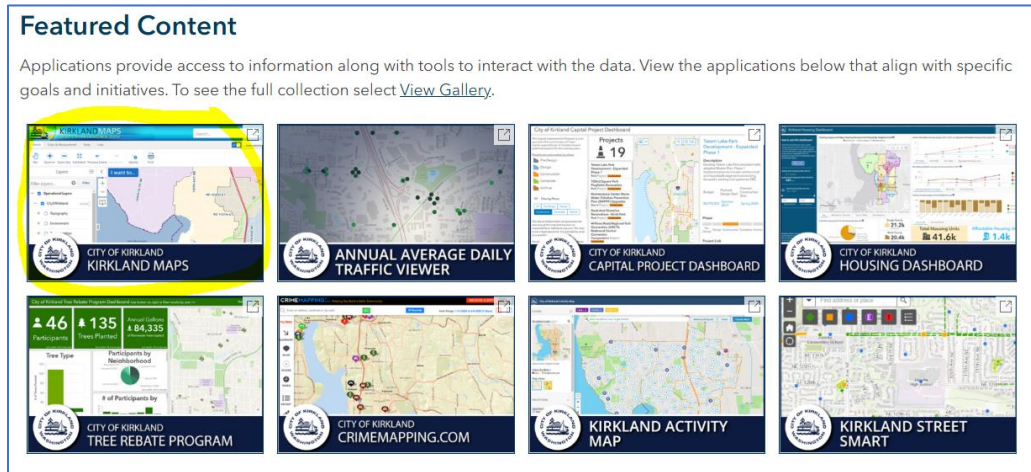


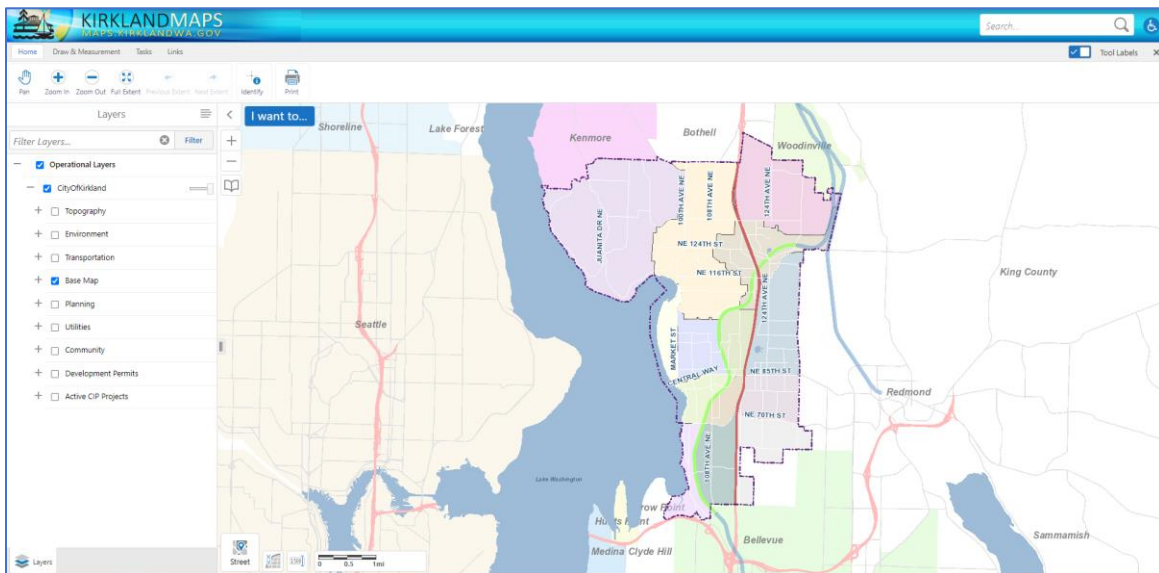
External GIS Steps:

Start by going to maps.kirklandwa.gov, to get to the Kirkland CityHub Online.

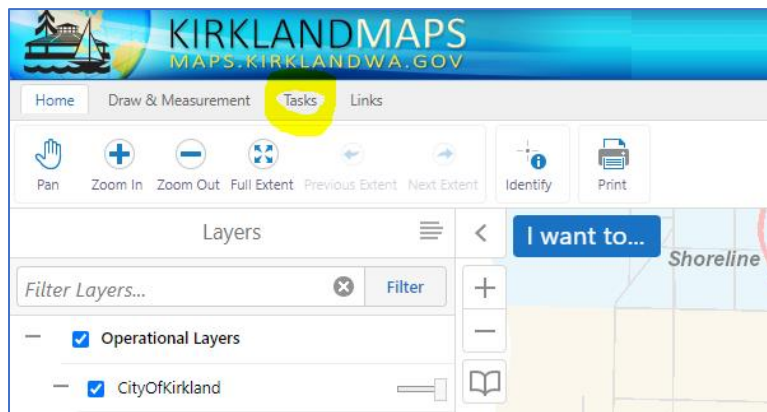
Under the Featured Content section click on the City of Kirkland KIRKLAND MAPS as seen below.



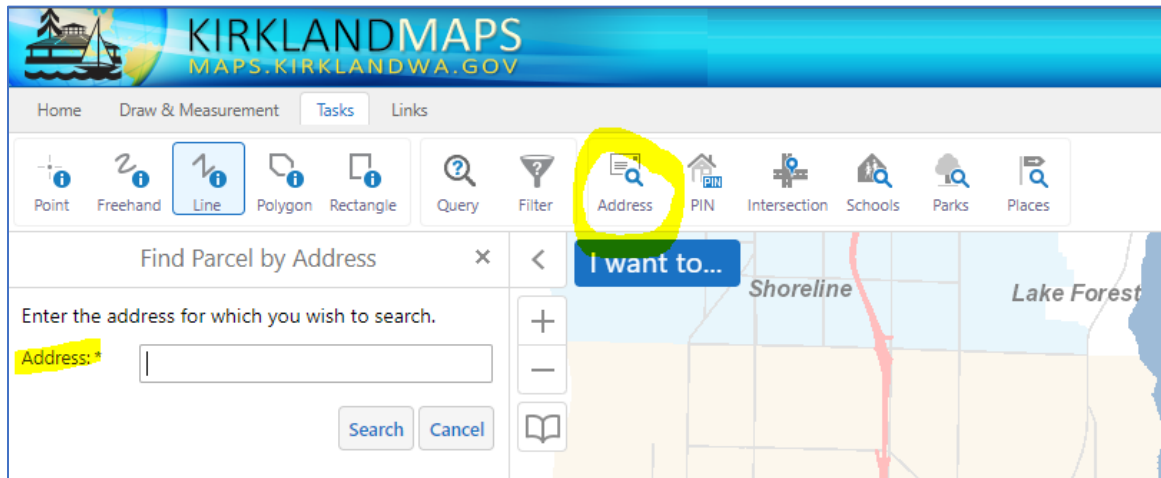
Clicking on the link should open the webpage as seen. Using Google Chrome can assist with any loading issues if the map isn't loading properly



Use the upper lefthand menu to navigate to the tasks tab to search by address or parcel number. For this sample we will use the address to City Hall (123 5th Ave).

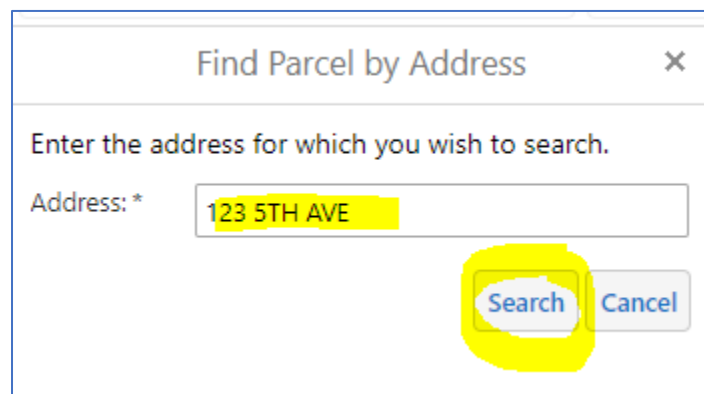


Clicking on the address option should bring up an option to type in the location you are looking to determine street classification.

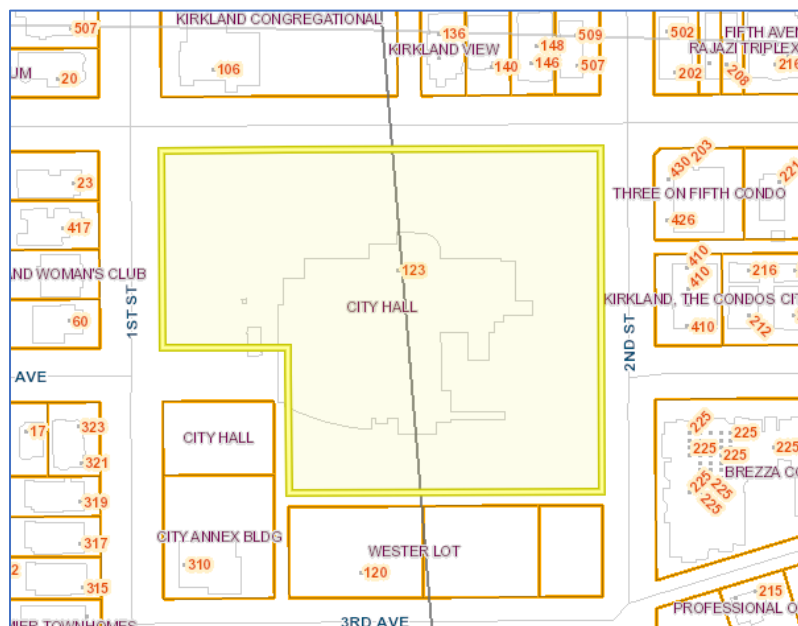


For this sample we will use Kirkland City Hall (123 5th Ave).

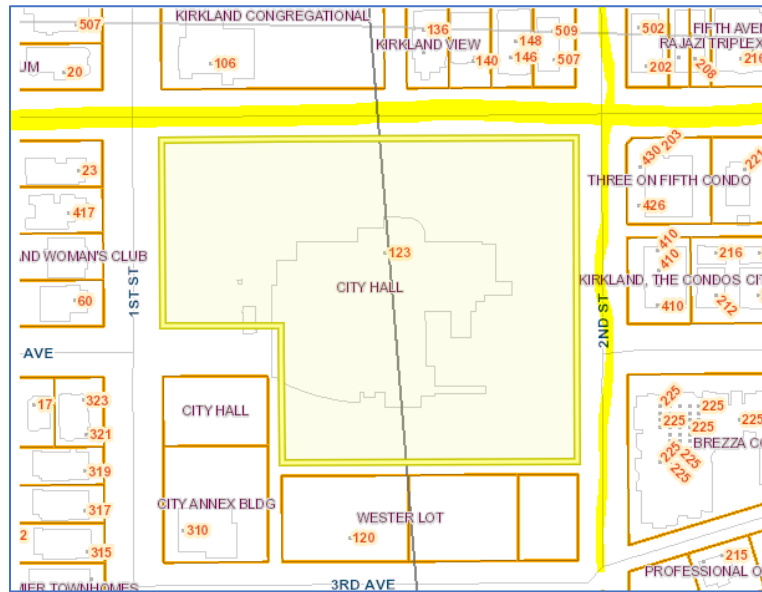
When you start typing in the address the system will start to bring up likely locations. Once found select the address and click search.



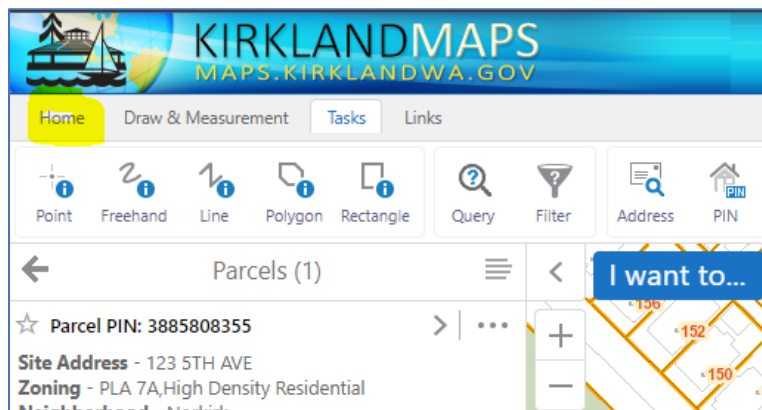
The map should navigate to the location and look like the map below.



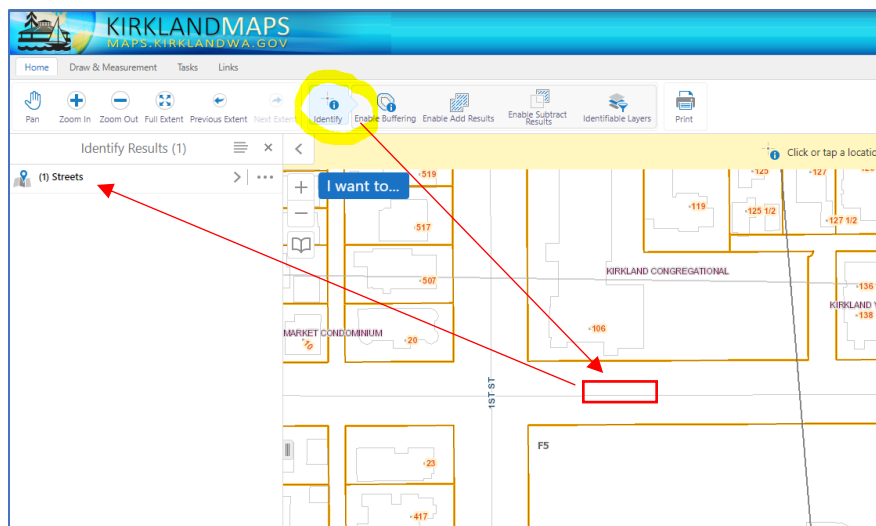
The highlighted street lines as seen below will be selected in the upcoming steps to determine street classification.



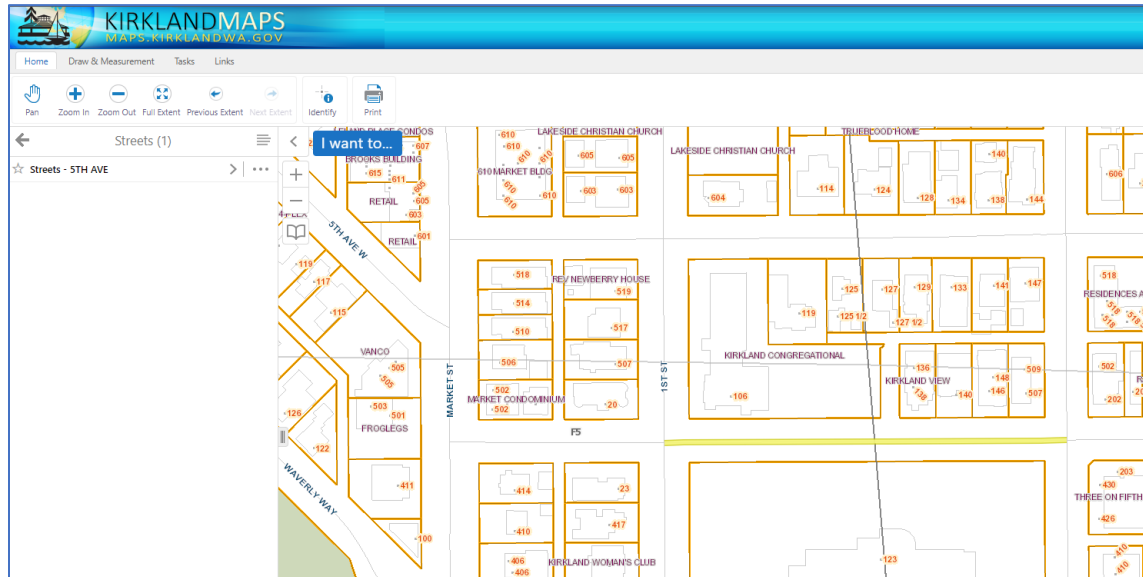
To make a selection navigate to the Home tab as seen from the upper left corner.



Use the identify tool from the upper menu to click and drag a box over this line to bring up the street within the left navigation.



Click on the streets from the left-hand menu which should highlight the street you have a selected, highlighted in yellow.



Click on the street name from the left-hand menu which should bring up the bottom menu which will list the street classification and other street related information.
