Answers to Questions

Question One:

However, the Rate and Service Structure you are requesting is a bit difficult to provide accurately, as we offer many services and each one can be customized based on the City of Kirkland's specific project needs.

For example, you have a line item for remove/replace foundation. This could have several different pricing options depending on size, location, traffic control and a ton of other variables.

My question is, would it be acceptable to provide a Rate and Service Structure that is T&M based? We could provide labor rates, equipment rates and then associated markups for Labor, Equipment, subs and materials. Along with this, we could provide a description of scopes of work we can perform.

Response One:

The RFP states:

"Please include a summary of fees charged for all services provided by your business. This summary should include all services described in the scope of work, along with the fees for any other related services provided by your business. A sample format and example line items are provided below."

So yes, it is acceptable to provide a rate structure that is T&M based so long as it addresses all the services described in the scope of work. The sample format given is just an example.
