

Volunteer Position Description

POSTION: Green Kirkland Restoration Volunteer

REPORTS TO: Green Kirkland Partnership staff person, Green Kirkland Steward, or Green

Kirkland Partnership contractor

LOCATION: City of Kirkland parks (one or more, various locations)

POSTION TYPE: One-time or ongoing restoration volunteer

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The Green Kirkland Partnership (GKP) is a program to restore over 400 acres of natural areas in City of Kirkland parks. Green Kirkland restoration volunteers attend restoration events led by GKP staff, GKP Stewards or GKP contractors (event leads). Volunteers engage in a variety of restoration activities as instructed by event leads. These volunteers are essential in accomplishing GKP's restoration goals.

SPECIFIC DUTIES:

- Engage in restoration activities as instructed by event lead. Activities
 include removing invasive plants, planting native trees and other plants,
 mulching, and watering.
- Follow safety and site boundary information provided by event lead

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Ability to attend the entire length of planned event
- All event volunteers must sign liability waiver (Volunteer Roster and Service Agreement for the City of Kirkland) at beginning of each event
- · Ability to follow direction given by event lead
- Ongoing volunteers must sign the Ongoing Park Neighborhood Volunteer Service Agreement

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Knowledge of and/or interest in natural areas restoration and invasive species removal practices
- Knowledge of Pacific Northwest native flora and common invasive plants
