Subject: ADDRESSING HATE AND BIAS-MOTIVATED VIOLENCE IN EAST KING COUNTY

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Human Services Commission receive a special presentation on Addressing Hate and Bias-Motivated Violence in East King County

BACKGROUND DISCUSSION:

Representatives of <u>Eastside for All</u> and <u>Chinese Information and Service Center</u> will provide an overview of the efforts to track incidents of hate and bias-motivated violence in East King County and what has been learned. These organizations are part of the larger King County Coalition Against Hate and Bias. More information about the coalition is available <u>here</u>.

Following the presentation, Commissioners will have an opportunity to ask questions during a moderated Q & A. Commissioners will participate next in small group discussions with Commissioners from Bellevue, Issaquah, Redmond and Sammamish to consider how the learnings from the Coalition's efforts could be supported by cites and inform the 2023-2024 human services grant funding priorities.
