Community Gardens

The community garden plots will be relocated to a new addition to Rose Hill Meadows Park in 2026 upon Council approval of a property donation adjacent to the park.



Pickleball

The City of Kirkland is partnering with the Lake Washington School District to dual stripe eight existing tennis courts at Kirkland Middle School and Finn Hill Middle School this summer. Kirkland Parks and Community Services is assessing community interest in (and costs for) converting one of our existing tennis courts at Peter Kirk Park to up to three pickleball courts in fall 2025.
