


Parks Funding Exploratory Committee Meeting #13

Local Land Acknowledgement

Purpose: The purpose of this PFEC meeting is for members to put forward a majority package of recommendations.





1. Approve priority for amenities


PFEC Decision Flow




















Vote: \$160M Capital Facility + Top 5 other elements (30-year funding)
