Little Vet School Summer Camp (Dogs) #16643 July 10-14 Weekdays 9a-12p ages 7-9

Every dog needs a friend! Students will role play the key responsibilities of a veterinarian and learn how to care for a dog. These future veterinarians will learn how to remove ticks, give immunizations, suture lacerations, read an x-ray, design their own veterinarian office, and explore dog digestion. Each student will receive a lab coat, plush dog, and diploma as a graduate of Little Veterinarian School upon completion of the course along with supplies for each class.

Little Doctor School Summer Camp #16644 July 17-21 Weekdays 9a-12p ages 7-9

Inspired learning today - healthy futures tomorrow! Students will role-play the key responsibilities of a doctor and learn about vital organs in the human body. These future doctors will practice suturing stitches and administering first aid; they will learn about the heart, lungs, bones, brain, spine, eyes, digestion, and how pharmacists play a role in prescribing medicine. Each student will receive a lab coat, stethoscope, and diploma as a graduate of Little Doctor School upon completion of the course.

Med School Summer Camp 4 Teens #16646 July 24-28 Weekdays 1p-4p ages 11-15

Thinking about a career in medicine? Students will role-play the key responsibilities of a doctor and how to administer first aid in emergency situations. These future doctors will learn about lung disease, water safety, how to perform CPR and Heimlich Maneuver, the different elements that make up blood, the several layers of skin, digestion, kidneys, broken bones, hypothermia, how to use a stethoscope, snake bites, and discuss the steps to become a doctor. Each student will receive a diploma as a graduate of Med School Camp 4 Teens upon completion of the program.

Wilderness Medicine Summer Camp #16647 July 31-Aug 4 Weekdays 9a-12p ages 7-10

Conquer the great outdoors! Students will role-play emergency situations in the wild and learn how to prepare for natural disasters.
