Northwest University Davis Building Master Plan Amendment, Case Number: ZON24-00896

Request: The applicant requests approval of a Process IIB zoning to amend the Northwest University Master Plan. The amendment proposes a change of use for the Davis Administrative Building (located at 5710 108th Avenue NE) to allow a Community Facility Use (defined in the KZC as a noncommercial or commercial use which provides public services, such as mental health crisis or other social and human services, food banks, and clothing banks) to lease and occupy the building. The use of the building would be limited to an administrative office for this use. No new structures or building expansions are proposed.


Public Hearing: Hybrid hearing will be held by Kirkland Hearing Examiner on July 17, 2025 at 1:00 p.m., (or as soon thereafter as possible) in the Council Chamber at 123 Fifth Avenue Kirkland, WA 98033 and online via Zoom. The Hearing Examiner will prepare a recommendation to the City Council for their final decision at a public meeting. The date of the City Council meeting has not been set.

Public Comment: During the hearing, anyone may speak. Written comments must be submitted by 11:00 a.m. on July 17, 2025, the day of the hearing. Comments may be submitted to the Hearing Examiner in care of Tony Leavitt, Senior Planner of the Planning Department. Please refer to Permit No. ZON24-00896 and include your name, address and e-mail address. Only people who speak at the hearing <u>or</u> submit written comments (other than petitions) are entitled to appeal the decision.

How to Participate in a Public Hearing

Follow these two (2) simple steps:

- 1. In the Public Notice (either posted on the large white sign erected on the subject property, posted on the City Hall bulletin board, or the publishing notice in the Seattle Times) make a note of the deadline date, the hearing date, and the hearing body.
 - The deadline date is the last day you may submit written comments if you will not attend the public hearing of if there will be a hearing on the proposal/project.
 - The hearing date is the day you may submit written and/or oral comments if you will attend the public hearing.
 - The hearing body is the group or individual who will consider the written and oral testimony.
- 2. You may participate in the public hearing process in either of the following ways:
 - Submit written comments to the appropriate hearing body either by:
 - a. Delivering these comments to the Kirkland Planning and Building Department, 123 Fifth Avenue, Kirkland 98033, by the deadline date; or
 - b. Giving your written comments directly to the hearing body at the public hearing.

For the Planning Commission, the Planning and Building Department encourages you to submit any written comments at least 8 days before the hearing date so they will be able to receive and read the comments prior to the meeting.

• Appear in person, or through a representative, at the hearing and giving oral comments directly to the hearing body.

To find out more:

- 1. Contact the City staff planner whose name and telephone number appears on the public notice and/or;
- 2. Come to the Kirkland Planning and Building Department between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM and request to see the project file (the project file number is noted in the public notice). The file will contain proposed site plans and building elevations (if applicable) and other information.
