Emerson Master Plan, Case No. **ZON25-00491**

Proposal: Tammy Chuang, the applicant for Lake Washington School District, is requesting approval of an amendment of the existing Master Plan for the Emerson Campus. The proposed project includes the construction of a new, 2-story, approximately 50,000 GSF public education building. The project will demolish the existing Emerson building and portable classroom building. The existing gym and Northstar Middle School will remain in place. Site improvements include new landscaped areas, new vehicle and pedestrian circulation, parking, service and utility yard, and geothermal loop. Enrollment for Emerson High School would increase by 167 students to a total of 345 students. The application was received by the City on July 11, 2025 and was deemed complete on August 13, 2025.

Location: 10903 NE 53RD ST

Neighborhood: Central Houghton


Review Process: The decision on this application will be made by the City Council, based on a recommendation from the City's Hearing Examiner. The process involves an opportunity for public comment in writing or at a public hearing to be held by the Hearing Examiner. Prior to the hearing, the Planning and Building Department will prepare a staff report making a recommendation on the application. Following the hearing, the Hearing Examiner will make a recommendation to approve, modify or deny the application. The City Council will make a decision on the application based on the recommendation of the Hearing Examiner and the record of comments and information provided to the Hearing Examiner. The decision will be based on whether the application complies with Kirkland's Zoning Code and other applicable codes. A hearing date has not yet been set. Notice of the hearing will be given at least 14 days before the hearing

Public Comment: Written comments received prior to 5 PM on. September 18, 2025 will be considered by the Planning and Building Department in preparing its recommendation and staff report to the Hearing Examiner. Written comments may be submitted to the Hearing Examiner at any time before the close of the public hearing. Oral comments may be provided at the hearing. Those who provide written or oral comments before the close of the public hearing, will receive a copy of the Hearing Examiner's recommendation for a IIB Permit. Others may obtain copies from the Planning and Building Department. APPEALS: The City Council's decision is the final decision of the City. Judicial review may be requested pursuant to state law.
