City of Kirkland Accessibility Request



The City of Kirkland strives to provide accessibility to and through all government facilities and remove barriers to public right-of-ways. The ADA Transition Plan addresses those areas that are not currently compliant and spells out the process and timeline to bring each area into compliance with the Title II Americans with Disabilities Act Standards. Individuals who find areas that need to be addressed may file an Accessibility Request with the ADA Coordinator.

The request should contain the following information:

- The requestor's name, address, email and telephone number (if any)
- The location (street address, building name) of the accessibility issue
- As detailed as possible the accessibility issue
