## Local Land Acknowledgement


















#### Opsis Option B with DOT Overlay



## 7 Flash Card Updates

- 4 Facility Cards
  - C-C (a): Facility: Aquatics and Recreation Center at Houghton Park & Ride (103k sq ft)
  - C-C (b): Facility: Aquatics and Recreation Center at Houghton Park & Ride (86k sq ft)
  - C-D (a): Facility: Redevelop North Kirkland Community Center (74k sq ft)
  - C-D (b): Facility: Redevelop North Kirkland Community Center (49k sq ft)
- Two for Teen Programs
  - O-D (a): Enhanced Recreation Programs for Youth and Teens
  - O-D (b): KTUB Operations and Enhanced Recreation Programs for Youth and Teens
- C-E: Green Loop Trail Priority Segments
  - We inadvertently added master plan to the original card, but we are able to do it with current CIP funding, so we removed "master plan" in this update. The cost of the card (\$5.3M) will remain the same because we hadn't increased the element cost with specific master plan costs.
